

Make a Star Jar

You will need

a jar (big enough to fit a battery light inside),
kitchen foil, plain paper, something pointy - like
a cocktail stick or a needle, scissors, glue,
a sharp pencil, a spoon.

To make your Star Jar...

Cut a rectangle of foil to fit inside your
jar. It should be wide enough to reach the
top + long enough to reach around the inside.

Glue it to plain paper and cut around it (this
makes the foil less easy to tear)

smooth the foil with the
back of a spoon



Plot your constellations with a pencil. Poke holes with your cocktail stick or needle to make the stars. Vary the size of the holes to make big and small stars.

Roll the foil into a tube + slip inside the jar. Finally, place your battery light inside the rolled foil so that the stars twinkle.

Optional Extras

Tie a ribbon around the neck of the jar.

Create a fancy label.

Add a few dabs of glitter glue to the outside of your jar.
